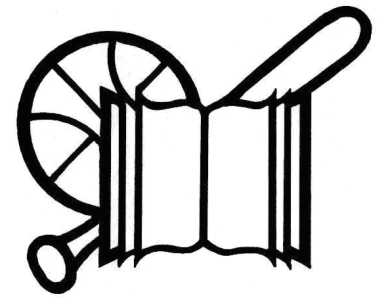
Extended Day Program

Camp Information

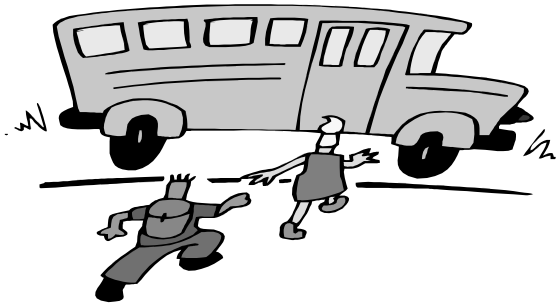

All campers will receive a camp shirt.

Campers will participate in a rotating schedule that will consist of Arts and Crafts, Computers, Game Room, Gym, Math, Reading, and Sports.
